Show respect and kindness in every interaction

If someone confides in you about themselves or someone else being harmed or unsafe, listen, reassure, and speak up (see left)

## **Follow the Rules**

A WWVP card, Code of Conduct, and Safe Church training are required for those serving on a team

Risk assessments help us identify hazards and put controls in place

Never 1:1 alone — always in a team or within line of sight

## **Everyone's Accountable**

We all answer to each other

No one serves or participates without oversight

We each have a responsibility to report hazards, incidents, or any indicators of harm
